2	<h2>COUNTRY THREAT LEVEL & SECURITY INFORMATION</h2> <p>Crime is the security concern that is most likely to affect travelers and expatriates in Australia. Demonstrations/strikes occur on occasion in large urban areas. Although protest actions do not usually affect the security environment, strikes have the potential to disrupt transportation and other services. Terrorism poses a serious concern in Australia, and transnational terrorists have repeatedly designated the country as a desirable target for attack. Environmental hazards -- including extreme weather conditions and the presence of dangerous, venomous creatures -- affect the safety and security environment for travelers.</p>

A/C ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

TSP: Requires all operators to have Transport Security Program Approved by the Dept of Home Affairs for operations within, to, or from Australia.

No Permit is Required

- Private – International flight entering, leaving, or flying in transit across
- Charter Intl Commercial Flts – <10 seats, 5 or fewer flts with <10-40 seats, 2 or fewer flts with <40-80 seats, single flts, single-entity freight flts, owner-use

Required Overflight Permission

- Non-ICAO Member States – International Flights by Foreign Aircraft
- Foreign State Aircrafts: 5 day application approval

Required Landing Permission

- Aircrafts taking on or discharging passengers, cargo, or mail
- Non-ICAO Member States – International Flights by Foreign Aircraft
- Foreign State Aircraft: 5 day application approval
- Military "Services" – 2 week notice is required if "military services" is requested.
